The Full Picture Summary

For this commission I proposed to make work that researched the barriers working-class community and creatives face within the creative industries. Once the commission began research took me to hone in particularly at adult literacy and art literacy and their connections to Dundee.

Instigating findings

- Scotland had the highest rate of adult literacy problems in the whole of the UK with 1 in 4 adults struggling in someway related to their lack literacy skills¹.
- Working-class occupations attend less cultural engagement than any other occupations, but more than two thirds attend contemporary over classical.
- The SIMD data map highlighted a significant amount of Dundee is living in the 20% most deprived zones.³
- From the SIMD data there are areas in Dundee that 70% of the working population have no qualifications and less than 3% accessing higher education.
- Dundee is behind the rest of Scotland in terms of Social Mobility.⁵
- There are similarities between the twelve most deprived areas in terms of education and the link to housing purpose built for industry workers.

Where the project went

I chose to concentrate on the barriers working-class creatives and communities may face in creative industries from a personal perspective, that I believe is a shared collective experience. That is the struggle with literacy and art literacy. I have often found myself not being able to access material in an art gallery or online due to the basis of it being text heavy and/or the text is just not accessible. Developing this idea, I made a split screen moving image work to express the feelings, I, myself have experienced and that of my friends and family that do not feel creative industries welcoming. I also chose to create a series of prints looking at the SIMD data maps and removing the data and putting visuals of analogue photography along with the data zone marker, a subversion of sorts of the access to so much data that it's overwhelming and the detachment of the places they are about.
